## eProject eXpress (ePX) Overview

- Secure, web-based project tracking/reporting system for ESPC projects
- Free resource maintained by LBNL for U.S. DOE
- Streamlined for use by State and Local Government project practitioners
- ePX enables Program and Project Owners and their ESCOs to securely:
  - Review top level statistical summary of all reported project activity in a state
  - Preserve and track summary project and Measurement & Verification data in perpetuity
  - Self-generate reports illustrating program and project impacts including: Utility (energy and water), Environmental (GHG) and Economic (jobs) impact
  - Archive project files along with the project summary data
  - Project specific information granted to registered ePX users by per project invitation only

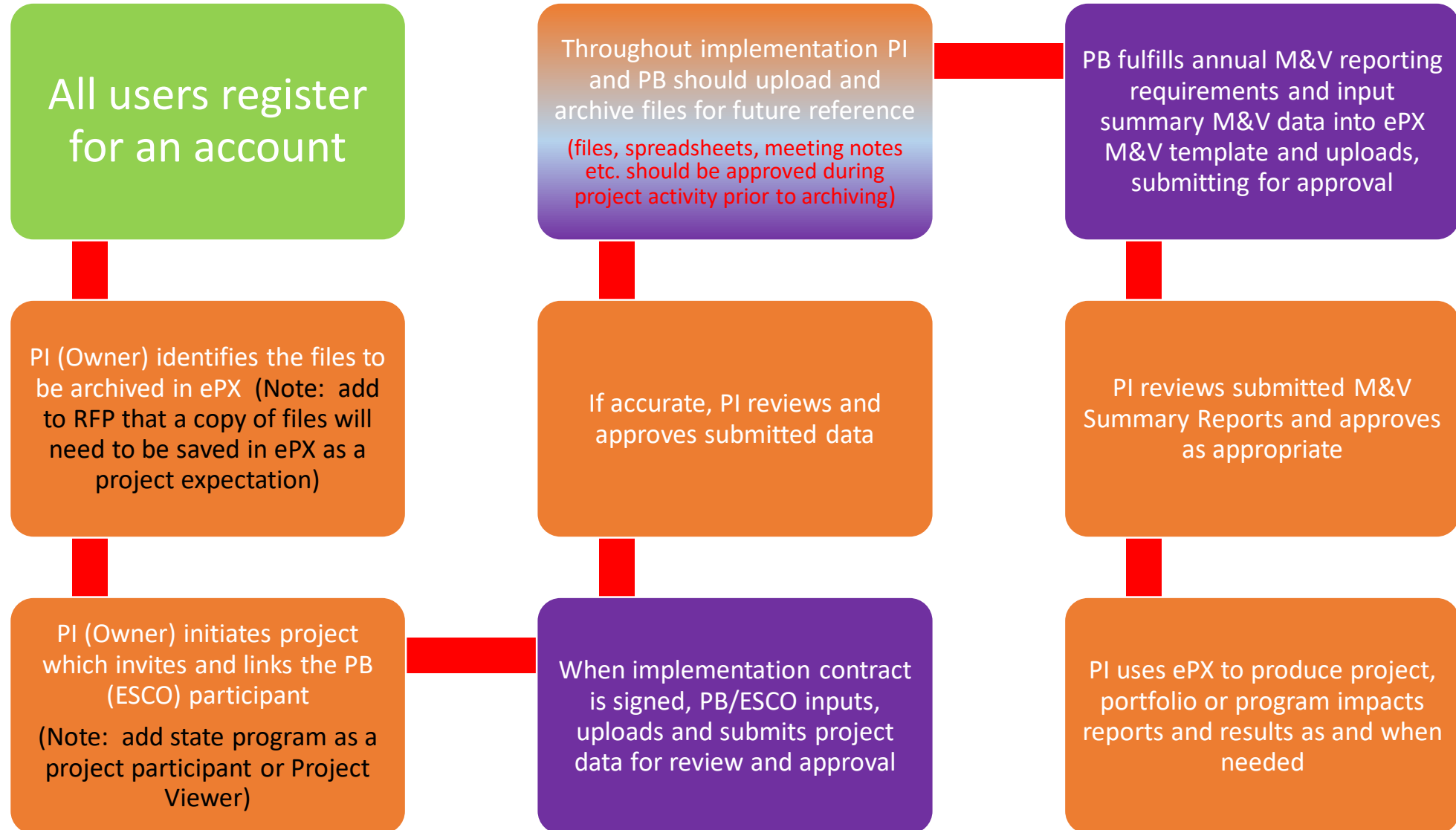

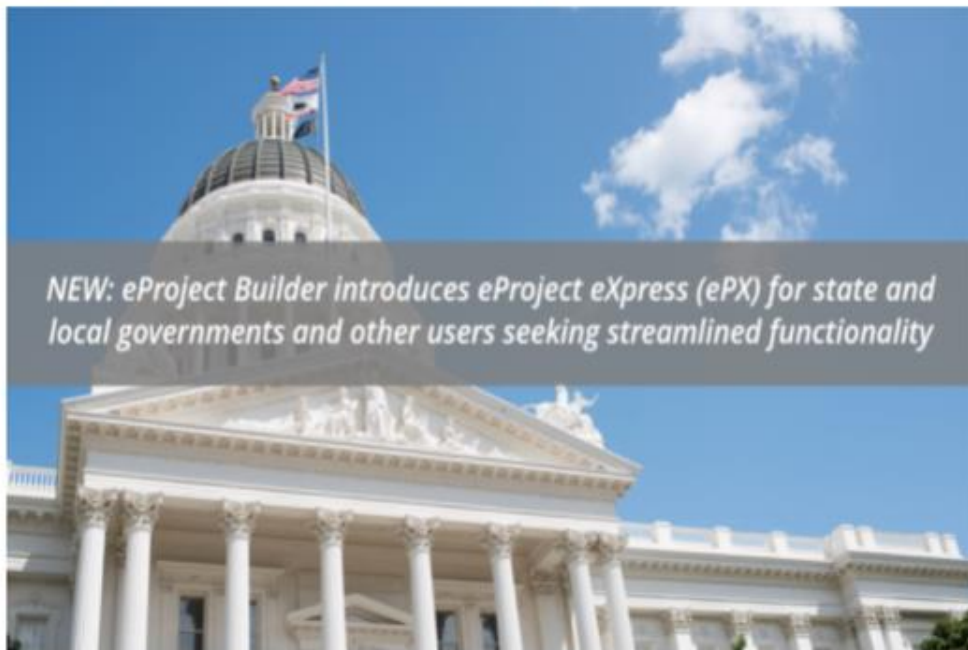

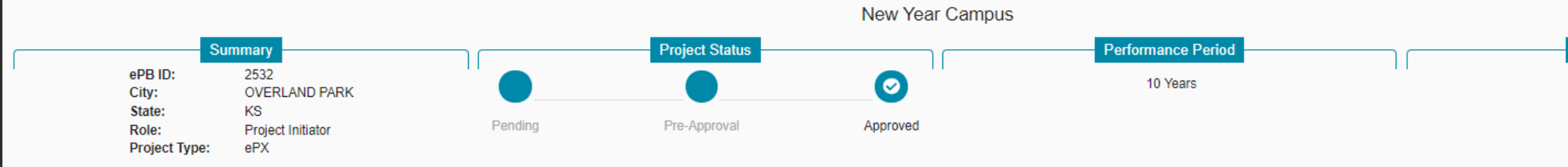
